When Allah swt sent His Messenger (saw) with His message of Islam, and called on his people and clan to the Iman to abandon idolatry, they denied it and insisted on clinging to their inherited ancestors'customs and traditions. RasoolAllah (saw) reprimanded them to unshackle themselves from the traditionswho did not think of their validity or vice. When Quraysh was unable to resist arguments, they resorted to the Jews to provide with ideas to defy the Prophet (saw). The Jews are a people of con-spiracy and treachery saying to them: inquire about three issues, if he answers then he is a prophet in which it is described in Surat al-Kahf and al-Isra.

When Quraysh was defeated intellectually, they resorted to the use of force; torturing and pursuing Muslims, and conspired to kill the Prophet (saw). The Muslims decided to migrate to Medina who also clashed with the Jews. The Prophet (saw) challenged them with proof and evidence, but were defeated intellectually, they resorted to defense of schemes and deception attempting to discredit Muslims in their religion and Iman. Thus rabbis took to declaring their Islam at the start of the day but renouncing it by nightfall to allege weakness of faith amongst the Muslims to abandon their Islam because to claim defect or fault.

Just as they carried out their plots, likewise vengeful Crusades came from every deep ravine to battle the Muslims; several crusade battles took place on most of the Muslim lands. However Allah swt sent them sincere obedient servants who clung to the Book of Allah (swt) and the Sunnah of His Messenger (saw) to perform Jihad for Allah's sake fearless from any reprimand like Saladin al-Ayoubiand his Mujahideen brothers who cleansed the Muslim lands from the Crusaders' impurities and their disbelief. Yet the vengeful Crusaders returned once again bringing with them machines of war and destruction, and occupied the Muslim land again in a new crusade. They soon realized that weapons alone do not achieve what they longed for, so they turned to the tactics of their Jewish forefathers in casting doubts and discredit among Muslims in their religion and Ageedah. The crusaders took to propagating their ideas and culture throughout Muslim lands with the façade of compassion while its core is poison, using the phrases: militancy and extremism, fanaticism and terrorism, fundamentalism. These terms are often aimed at describing Muslims who carry Dawah, who adhereto their Islam and reject Western civilization and do not accept it as a substitute for Islam, or whose actions do not please the West.

In return, they placed counter-terms such as: moderation, leniency and tolerance, flexibility and acceptance of others, democracy, and respect for the majority opinion, and often drive these phrases to describe Muslims who carry the call to Western civilization, and accept its substitute for Islam, or who engage in acts that satisfies West

in general.

Thus debates and dialogues swirled around moderation. Speakers, whom were considered scholars and thinkers, discussed these issues and leaders of political parties all strived to portray the image of Islam as a religion of moderation and tolerance which knows neither extremism nor militancy rather is a moderate religion. They quoted Ayat and Hadith portraying its tolerance and moderation, and further used the Ayah, "That was a nation which has passed on. It will have [the consequence of] what it earned, and you will have what you have earned. And you will not be asked about what they used to do." [TMQ 2: 134] Conferences, seminars, and dialogues were held which carried over into various types of media: print, audio, and visual. This was achieved with the support of countries that recognize Islam only as a spiritual religion, focusing on worship rituals, that has no place in daily lives. These states disguised themselves with a legitimate Islamic covering to continue their criminal actions against the Ummah from harassment and genocide, and distorting the religion through their curriculum and platforms. Presently after deep contemplation, dismallyfar from accurately understanding Islam in the abyss of deceitupon Muslims to intensify misery; widening the gap between Muslims and their religion. We emerged trying to reconcile Islam and Kufrinventingvarious terms and arguments dressing Kufr withan Islamic dressing.
