30,000 Rally to Unite Voices in Defense of Palestine with Jihad and the Caliphate

NATIONAL HEADLINE | 27/01/2025 | 4-minute read Action of 30,000 People Unite to Defend Palestine with Jihad and Caliphate

*.info – More than 30,000 Islamic scholars, community leaders, preachers, politicians, entrepreneurs, Muslim intellectuals, and the general Muslim public gathered at the National Monument (Monas) to unite in voicing their support for Palestine through jihad and the caliphate on Sunday (26/1/2024).

During the "Masirah Kubra: Isra' Mi'raj, The Ummah Unites to Liberate Al-Aqsa and Palestine," the masses marched from the Horse Statue near Monas to the U.S. Embassy, where they listened to speeches from scholars and community leaders.

Throughout the march, banners featuring *liwa* (white flags inscribed with the declaration of faith) and *rayah* (black flags with the same inscription) were prominently displayed. Chants of *"The Muslim Ummah Unites to Free Palestine!"* echoed along the route, with large *rayah* flags being carried by participants.

Muhammad Karebet and Febi R hosted the speeches in front of the U.S. Embassy. Around eight speakers from various professions voiced the same call for defending Palestine—not through ceasefires or dialogue, but through the caliphate and jihad.

Muslim scholar KH Rokhmat S Labib, the first speaker, emphasized that temporary or permanent ceasefires are not the ultimate solution for the Palestinian issue. "The solution for Palestine, as mandated by Allah SWT, is war to expel the Jewish occupiers from Palestinian lands," he asserted.

The second speaker, Banten scholar Kiai Mansur, pointed out the U.S. support behind Zionist Jews, urging Muslims not to remain passive.

"Muslims are obligated to defend Palestine," he declared.

Another speaker, Muslim intellectual Ustadz Muhammad Ismail Yusanto (UIY), explained the practical reason why jihad is the solution for Palestine. "The Jewish occupiers understand no other language but that of force," he stated firmly.

The final speech was delivered by Banten scholar Kiai Yasin Muthahar, who emphasized that the struggle for Palestine will continue until Allah's promised help arrives, as stated in Islamic teachings—the emergence of Islamic leadership.

"The ultimate solution for Palestine is jihad and the caliphate," he concluded.

At exactly 11:00 a.m., the event concluded with a prayer led by Kiai Yasin Muthahar. The participants were deeply moved, shedding tears as prayers were offered for Allah to help their brothers and sisters in Palestine and to destroy the Jewish forces.

The march was broadcast live on the YouTube channel One Ummah TV, with over 86,000 viewers from within and outside the country tuning in.

On social media, hashtags such as #AynalMuslimun, #WeNeedKhilafah, and #SaveP4lest1ne trended widely.
