

Interim Government of Bangladesh Must Warn India about her Impudence towards the People of Bangladesh

During his three-day visit to the United States, India's top opposition (Congress Party) leader, Rahul Gandhi has commented at the National Press Club in Washington DC on Wednesday that India is concerned about the rise of "extremism" and "violence" in Bangladesh.
