Under the Name of Culture, Openness and Modernity, Shyness (*Hayaa*) is Being Undermined in the so-called Carthage Theater Festival

Billions are spent in a few days by the state to spread obscenity, destroy the high values and strike the beliefs instead of reviving the Ummah's culture and introducing its men of Fuqaha' (scholars), engineers, doctors and scientists like Al-Taher bin Ashour, Khader Hussein and Sheikh Zaghouani and Saheb Etabaa' and others...

Instead of providing the opportunity to know the history of this country and what the men did, such as Musa bin Naseer, the seven 'Abadilah (Abdullahs), 'Uqba ibn Nafi' and Tariq ibn Ziyad, the callers of secularism - rulers of Tunisia are trying to strip this Ummah, with the support and generosity of her enemies, and to defame all forms of chastity and purity.
